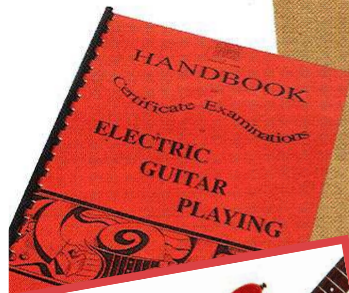

Sessionette 75

Stuart Ward, the man who invented the Sessionette 75, describes this great little combo as “the only amp that does anything interesting with solid-state”. It features all-transistor technology, twin-channel operation with preset or variable EQ, and it’s very loud for its size. Retailing for only £199 when it first came out in 1981, it was one of the few non-valve amps actually worthy of the label ‘valve sound’. A good second-hand Sessionette 75 will cost about the same now as it did when it was new – a good indication of the popularity of this little amp.
